- The recycling center (3480 S Old State Road 37) is a great place to pick up cardboard for your boat
  - Please arrive at the pool by 3:00 P.M. for creative boat judging
- Rain-out Date: Saturday, October 1, 2011.

## Official Rules:

1. Boats must be made ONLY of cardboard and duct tape
  - Cardboard cannot be sealed with any paint or sealants
  - Duct tape may be of varying colors for creativity, but it must have come manufactured in that color
  - If any illegal items used in construction are discovered during the pre-race inspection, the boat will be disqualified from the event
  - Boats from previous years may not be used; each boat must be made completely new each year
2. Boats shall be designed to race with a two-person crew
  - Each person will be equipped with a paddle and lifejacket provided by the race committee.
  - The race must begin and end with the two-person crew intact for the boat to qualify for the Fastest Boat category
3. Boats must comply with length and width restrictions
  - Boats shall not exceed 8 feet in length
  - Boats shall not exceed 4 feet in width
  - Boats exceeding the length and width restriction will be subject to elimination
4. Boats will be raced for time in heats
  - Each heat will consist of five (5) boats (number may vary based on total number of entries)
  - Each boat will travel 50 meters (one length of the pool)
  - Times from heats will determine the division places as well as the overall awards
  - The 5 fastest times from heats will race for fastest boat overall.
5. Boats will be judged on their creativity as part of the pre-race activities.
  - Boats must be present at designated judging area by 4:00 P.M. on race day
  - Areas used in judging the Most Creative category will include:
    - ◆ Ship design
    - ◆ Creative use of cardboard and duct tape
    - ◆ Overall theme
    - ◆ Costumes
    - ◆ Enthusiasm and showmanship
6. Prizes will be awarded according to the following criteria:
  - 3 fastest teams
  - 3 most creative boats
