

Why publish with the *Journal of Youth and Adolescence*?

- Rapid review – typically less than 21 days
- Quick publication – corrected proofs published on-line within weeks
- Fast-track print publication – now 10 issues per year to allow for needed flexibility
- Highly cited – according to ISI, the *Journal* is the most cited to of its kind
- Respectable Impact Factor – 1.214, according to ISI 2006 rankings
- Highly available – according to WorldCat and compared to other "adolescent" journals, it is in the most libraries worldwide and is in the most academic electronic search engines
- Multidisciplinary – spans many fields in materials it publishes and audiences it reaches
- High volume – now over 100, full-length articles published per volume
- Room for exploration – many manuscripts average between 40 to 45 manuscript pages
- Trailblazer – the first journal dedicated to this area of study
- Efficient – internal reviews quickly inform authors if their manuscripts are outside the journal's mission
- Responsive – work directly with the Editor-in-Chief who ensures that you get results
- High aspirations – the editorial board is on an aggressive campaign to further increase the journal's stature
