**The Irving and Shirley Brand Graduate Fellowship**

The Irving and Shirley Brand Graduate Fellowship was created to honor President Myles Brand's parents, Irving and Shirley Brand. The fellowship is an annual fellowship for IUB incoming or current graduate students in the Humanities, with preference given to students of Philosophy.

**Nomination Process:** Any department can nominate **one** doctoral or master's student who is in a Humanities field. The Awards and Financial Aid Committee, a standing committee of the Graduate Council, will make the selections.

The student, either by their own initiative or by the department's request, will submit an application online:

1. The student submits their application online through OneStart >> Services >> Student Self-Service >> Services & Information >> Financial >> "Bloomington Graduate Fellowship Application"
  - a. They will be required to attach their personal statement, vita/resume and recommendation letters.
2. The Fellowships Coordinator will email the student's application and required materials to their department after all materials have been received.
3. All nominations must be submitted to our office by email to the Fellowships Coordinator: Yvonne Dwigans, ylivings@indiana.edu, in one pdf document and must consist of the following:
  - a. Letter of nomination from the Director of Graduate Studies or Department Chairperson;
  - b. Any additional information the department may want to include

**Award Value:** This is a single-year award valued at **\$5,000**. **Note:** The award **must** be used for the year it is awarded. A recipient **cannot** place this award into a "reserve status" because of receiving another award.

**Deadlines:**

All Student materials must be submitted electronically through the University Graduate School Fellowship Application System located in the Student Self-Service section in OneStart.

**Student Deadline:** Students need to have all materials submitted to their department by **Friday, April 13, 2012**.

**Department Deadline:** All materials need to be submitted to The University Graduate School by **Friday, April 27, 2012**.

\*Letters of recommendation must appear on department letterhead and bear the signature of the recommender. Scanned versions of paper recommendation letters are acceptable. Electronic recommendation letters bearing electronic signatures are also accepted. Unsigned recommendations will not be accepted thus eliminating a student's application for consideration.
