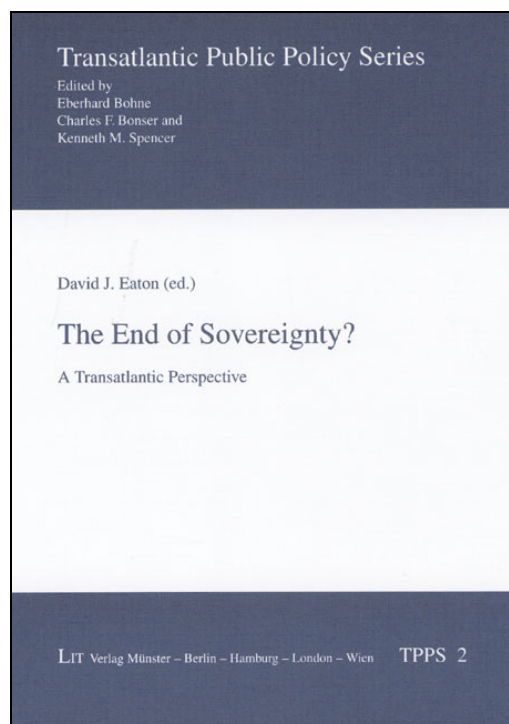

The provocative papers of the volume focus on the concept of internal and external sovereignty which is critical on both sides of the Atlantic.
