



Indiana University Bloomington - Office of Admissions Guidance Counselor Newsletter - Fall 2011

The deadline for Automatic Academic Scholarship and Selective Scholarship consideration is November 1. All application materials for admission must be submitted online or postmarked by November 1. Students who meet the November 1 deadline may submit updated SAT or ACT scores by January 15th for reconsideration for Automatic Academic Scholarships.

IU Bloomington is now super scoring the ACT! For students entering fall 2012, we'll combine the highest scores for each subtest from different exams for a new ACT composite. We'll also consider the highest critical reading and math component scores of the SAT. We encourage students to test several times to improve their chances for admission and scholarships.

Info about the math requirement: Students applying for fall 2012 must complete seven semesters of mathematics, including one semester of pre-calculus, trigonometry, or calculus. - [IU High School program](#) courses
- [IU Independent study](#) courses
- Ivy Tech courses: MAT 133 (will receive M025 credit with a C grade or higher), MATH 134 (will receive M026 credit with a C grade or higher), and dual credit Ivy Tech courses 136 or 137 (no IU course credit will be given but these courses will count for the curriculum math requirement)
- Vincennes University courses: Math 102 (will receive M025 credit with C grade or higher) and Math 104 (will receive M026 credit with a C grade or higher)
- A dual credit course titled College Algebra, Pre-calculus, or Trigonometry from a regionally accredited institution

Facts and figures for IU's Class of 2015: Here are just a few points of pride about the incoming class, which was awarded a record number of merit-based awards, including 51 Cox Scholarships, 654 IU Excellence Awards, and 128 Valedictorian Awards and has among its numbers 56 Herbert Presidential Scholars and 224 Hudson & Holland Scholars:

- Class size: 7,424
- GPA middle 50%: 3.4 to 4.0
- SAT middle 50%: 1060 to 1250
- ACT middle 50%: 24 to 29
- Just for Indiana residents: the average SAT was 1185, the average GPA was 3.73, and 79.5% were in the top quarter of their high school classes
