Session one begins promptly at **3:30 p.m.** with session two following at **4:15 p.m.** Students need only attend one 45-minute session. Each alumnus will speak specifically to those individuals who have expressed interest in their career field. The panelists will describe their career paths and places of employment, followed by a Q-and-A opportunity.
