Program Fees and Flights

Program fees, which have remained unchanged for the third year in a row, range from \$3,500 to \$4,500.

Participating students are required to travel to and from the host country on group flights since Program instructors accompany students. Group flights typically begin in Chicago or Indianapolis.

Program Fees Include

- ◆ Transportation within the host country (Students may prepay and receive reimbursement with proper documentation)
- ◆ Course manuals and instruction
- ◆ Lodging and meals with a host family stay
- ◆ Medical insurance
- ◆ Laundry except for Mexico participants
- ◆ Program-directed field trips and activities
- ◆ Program-related memorabilia (i.e. Program t-shirt, etc.)

Program Fees Do *Not* Include

- ◆ Test application fee
- ◆ Travel costs to regional centers for testing and interviewing as part of the application process
- ◆ Potential printing and postage for application and acceptance materials
- ◆ Travel costs to Bloomington for IUHPFL Orientation
- ◆ Passport fees and photographs
- ◆ Physical exam prior to leaving
- ◆ Transportation to/from your hometown and the U.S. point of departure (typically Chicago or Indianapolis)
- ◆ Transportation from U.S. point of departure (typically Chicago or Indianapolis) to host country **on required group flights**
- ◆ Meals on certain overnight excursions (two to three meals ranging from \$10-\$15 USD each)
- ◆ Personal expenses abroad such as souvenirs, gifts, postage, optional activities, etc.
- ◆ Optional field trips and activities that are not part of the IUHPFL Program curriculum

Funding
