A Little Background on the Hillcrest Apartments: The Collins Living-Learning Center and RPS established Hillcrest apartments more than a decade ago as a way to retain juniors and seniors, who will serve as mentors and role models to younger members of the LLC community. Hence, preference is given to current or returning residents who will be juniors and seniors the semester they move in, although those who will be sophomores also may apply. The LLC Director and the RPS Residence Manager review applications and solicit advice and recommendations from other staff and Collins student leaders. We encourage and welcome a wide diversity of applicants.

What You Should Know Before You Apply

- The room fees for living at Hillcrest are slightly higher than for other rooms at Collins.
- Hillcrest contains one bedroom and two bedroom apartments.
- If someone you've named as a roommate for a two-bedroom apartment either does not apply or is not accepted to Hillcrest, you may be assigned another roommate. Please make sure ALL roommates who would like to live together submit applications.
- Hillcrest residents are required to purchase a minimal meal plan and are expected to eat in the Collins Dining Hall on a regular basis.
- Once you've been accepted to Hillcrest, you do not need to re-apply for the following year. Residence in Hillcrest is limited to three (3) years.
