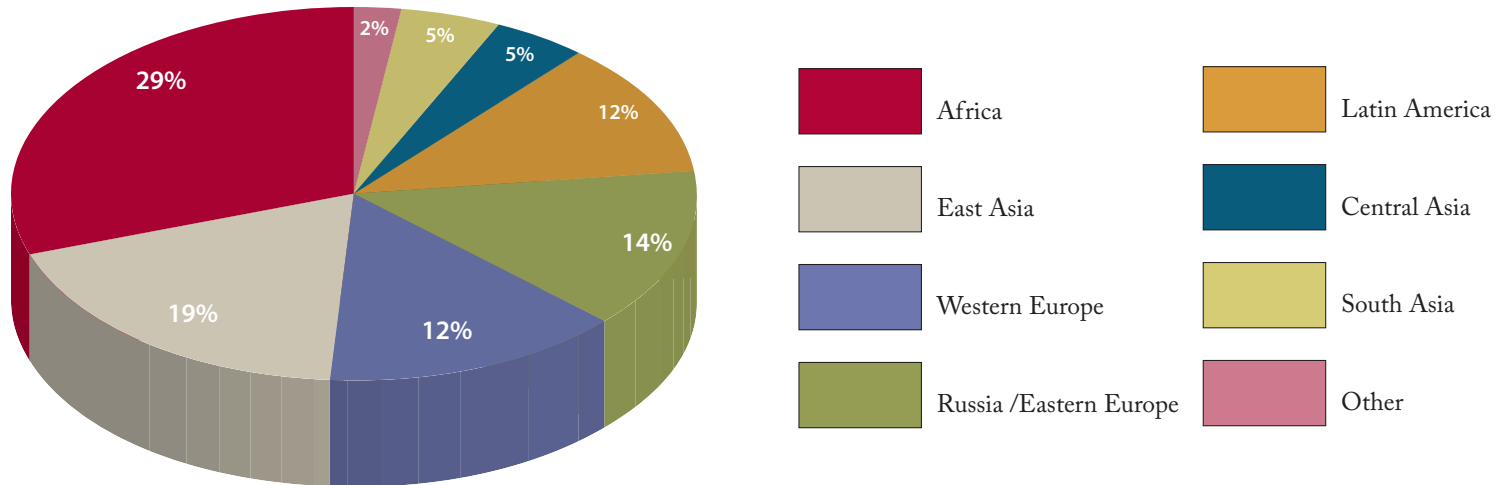

## SUMMER PRE-DISSERTATION TRAVEL GRANT

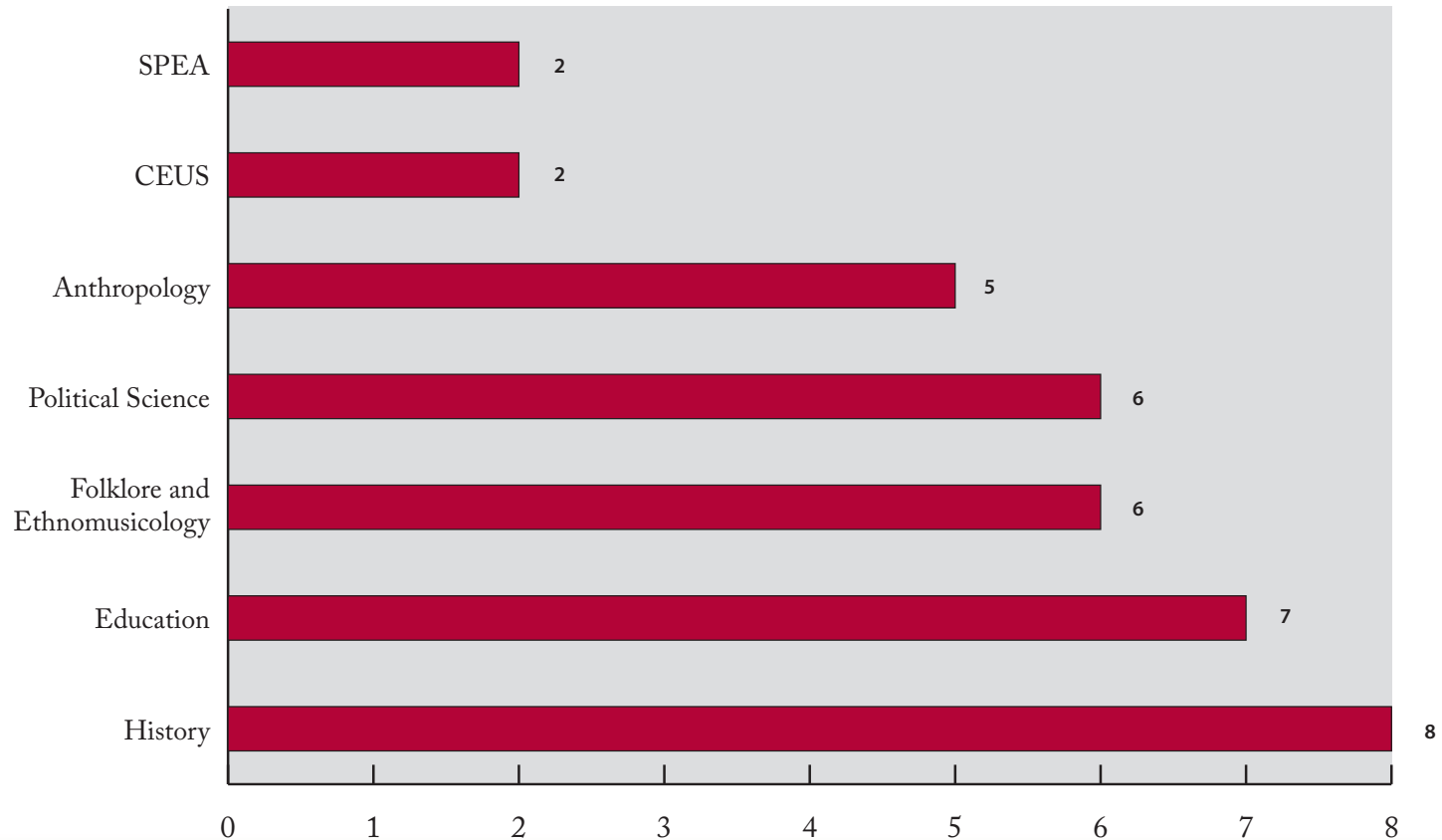

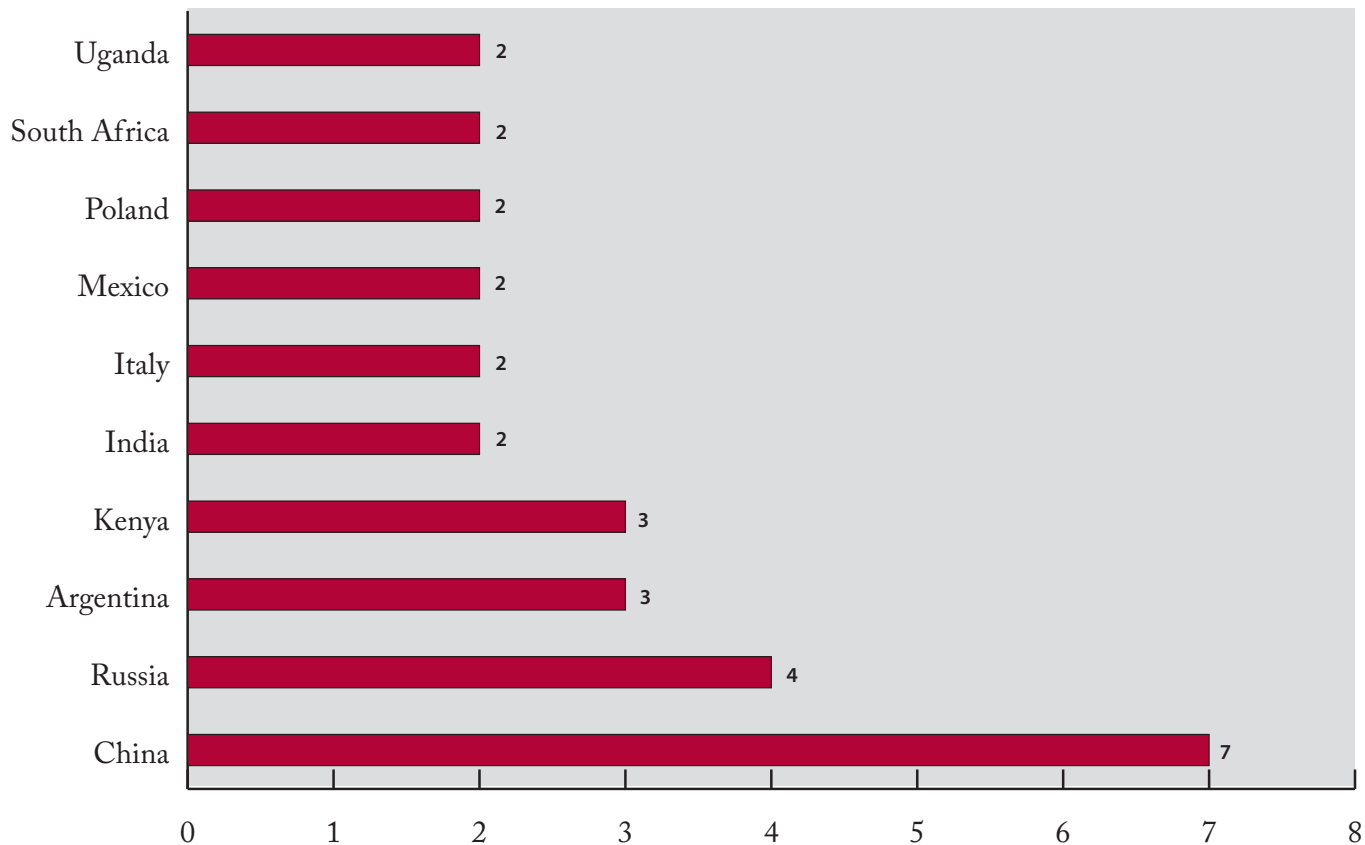
PRE-DISSERTATION TRAVEL GRANT RECIPIENTS BY REGION, 2002–2005 (5 years, 43 grants)

## INTERNATIONAL ENHANCEMENT GRANT COMPETITIONS, 2001-2006

The International Enhancement Grant, created by the OVPIA and co-funded by the University Graduate School, enables graduate students to participate in directed external opportunities for which traditional financial aid is not available.

2002-03: 53 applicants, 14 grants

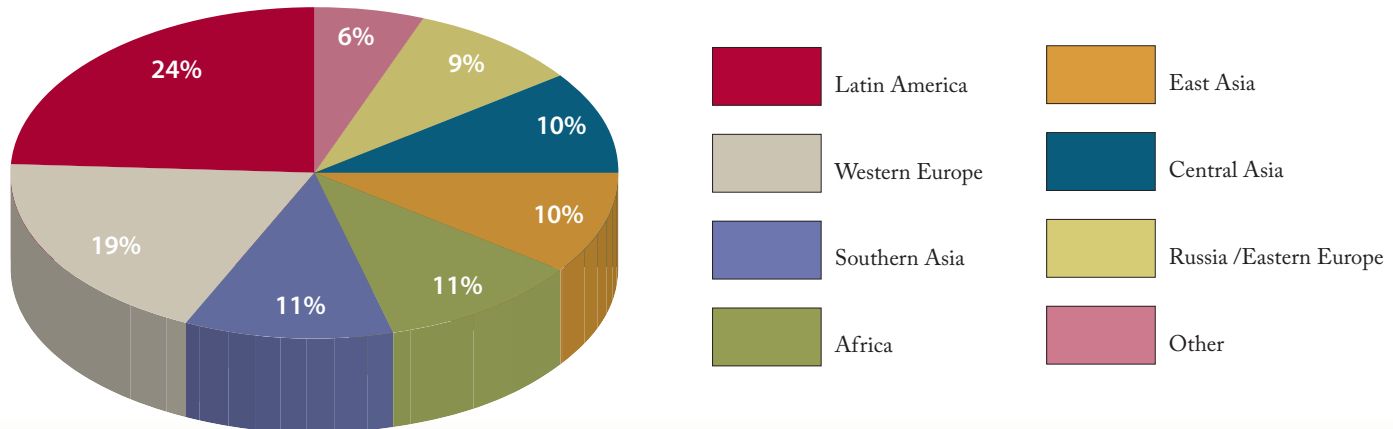
2003-04: 53 applicants, 14 grants
