Graduate Student Foreign Language Proficiency

Students within the Department of Spanish and Portuguese

To fulfill the University Graduate School's language proficiency requirement in Spanish, Portuguese or Catalan, please fulfill one of the following:

All courses must be taught within the target language.

Spanish

1. By completing, with a grade of B (3.0) or better, Hisp S105, or the equivalent, and one course at the 500-level or higher (excluding Hisp S517)

Portuguese

1. By completing, with a grade of B (3.0) or better, P135, or the equivalent, and one course that the 500-level or higher.

Catalan

1. By completing, with a grade of B (3.0) or better, two courses at the 400-level or higher.

In-Depth

1. The student must first establish proficiency in the language by one of the methods listed above (Spanish, Portuguese or Catalan). The student must then pass, with a grade of B (3.0) or better, another course at the 500-level or higher.
