**Lecturer in National and/or International Affairs**

The School of Public and Environmental Affairs (SPEA) at Indiana University seeks to appoint a Lecturer for the Bloomington campus. This is a non-tenure-track, full-time, and potentially permanent faculty position with an initial multi-year commitment and primary obligations in the areas of teaching, teaching-related services, and student advising. SPEA is interested in candidates with strong teaching interests in domestic U.S. policy and administration and/or international affairs. Preference will be given to candidates with a Ph.D. or advanced degree in national policy, international studies, international relations or diplomacy, combined with substantial professional experience in national and/or foreign policy or international affairs. Candidates must have at least two years post-secondary teaching experience in the areas of national and international affairs, preferably at a school of public affairs. Applicants must present evidence of a strong commitment to high-quality teaching and teaching-related services.

More than one candidate may be hired through this search. We would consider other non-tenure-track appointments, perhaps at the level of Clinical Assistant Professor, depending on the qualifications of the applicant.

SPEA is a multidisciplinary division of Indiana University and is organized as a professional school committed to excellence in research, teaching, and service and to addressing critical issues of public policy and management. Faculty members teach required and elective courses at the undergraduate, professional masters, and doctoral levels. SPEA is one of the largest U.S. public affairs schools in the nation with over 75 tenure-track faculty on the Bloomington campus.
