August 2002 to Present: Senior Lecturer, School of Public & Environmental Affairs:

I have continued to teach governmental and nonprofit accounting and financial management. My assignment, in **Spring 10**, included teaching two courses. V526: Financial Management in Non-Profit Organizations, and V346: Undergraduate course in Governmental Accounting and Reporting. During, **Fall 10**, I taught two undergraduate classes: V346, Government Accounting and Reporting and V246, Elements of Government and non-profit Accounting Cycle. Being the lead instructor in V246, I rewrote the purpose of V246 to make it more suitable to prepare students for higher level classes in accounting, finance and management.

I also presented a seminar, through SPEA Exe Ed, to Umbagh & Associates, A Public Accounting Company in Indianapolis.

August 2000 to 2002: Visiting Assistant Professor of Public and Environmental Affairs. I have been teaching governmental and nonprofit accounting, financial management and public finance administration to undergraduate classes.
