Application Checklist:

- Application form** – submitted online
- One official transcript** – from each college attended, regardless of if degree was conferred. (If you attended Indiana University, you need not submit a transcript: we can obtain it from the Registrar.)
- Three letters of recommendation** – preferably from a faculty member. Your recommender may submit a recommendation letter, as a PDF copy, via email to speaapps@indiana.edu. If you prefer to send in a paper recommendation, please have your recommender complete the reference form found at this link: http://www.indiana.edu/~spea/pubs/ma_reform.pdf
- GRE or GMAT scores** – Our institution code is 1324. Our GRE department code is 2204.
- TOEFL or IELTS scores** – for international students (Our institution code is 1324. Our TOEFL department code is 94.)
- Statement of purpose** – the average length is two pages.
- Departmental Questions** – (<http://www.indiana.edu/~spea/specform/spec.html>)
 - If you have already completed your personal statement, you do not need to complete section # 3 of this form.
- Résumé or CV** – may be mailed to our office or emailed to speaapps@indiana.edu. Subject line: Application Resume.
- \$55 application fee** (\$65 for international students) – The electronic application requires payment by credit card upon submission.
