Spring Silent Auction

Attention All University Club Members:

Preparations for this April's Spring Luncheon Auction have begun and your participation is needed now to continue to "grow" the University Women's Club Auction to benefit the University Club's Scholarship Fund for I.U. students. Last year's Auction raised some \$1118 for the Scholarship. The University Women's Club goal is to exceed this amount.

Each club member's help is needed to help the Auction reach that goal! Please arrange for donations of goods, services, (or other monetary donations) by following these steps:

1. *BY March 8, 2010 mail or e-mail the ITEM VALUE AND DESCRIPTION FORM (on the back of this flyer) to the UClub Office.*

- *DONATION ITEMS can range from home-made baked goods and art/craft/stationers items to computer instruction, I.U. sports event tickets, "White Elephant" item (art glass or other gently used house wares), one-week time-share vacations, and donations from local businesses/service-providers.*
- *DO YOU KNOW A CATERER, A PUBLISHED WRITER, A LOCAL RESTAURANTEUR, A LOCAL BUSINESS-OWNER OR SERVICE PROVIDER? Select one or two to ask for a donation to the auction.*
- *EXAMPLES:*

Two free dinners at a Restaurant, signed copy of a Book by a local published author, two Spring annuals from a Greenhouse, one free Beauty salon service from a salon owner, free Massage from your favorite masseuse, Art supplies from a local supply store, Art piece from an artist you know, Gift certificate or free service from a local business or professional (Dentist, Attorney, Bookseller, Butcher, Grocer, Picture-framing shop, Camera shop, Golf course, Shoe shop, Pet supply store, Bakery, Car wash, Furniture store) ... Or another source of your choosing. (Donated items may be tax deductible)

2. *Attend the University Women's Club Spring Luncheon, (bring a guest!) and make bids at the Silent Auction. (In late March you will receive a list of the items to be auctioned.)*
3. *Note that donated goods must be at the luncheon venue and must be retrieved at the end of the luncheon if no bids are placed on them. There will be no storage space available.*
