Medical Annual Deductible	\$900 individual (\$2,700 family) (Applies to all services except wellness, emergency, prescriptions, mental health, and transplant benefits)	
Medical Out-of-Pocket Maximum	\$2,400 individual (\$7,200 family) then there is no medical copay. (All copays and deductibles, except prescription drug and human organ transplants, apply toward this maximum.)	
Medical Copay	15% after deductible.
