Fran Snygg Endowment Fund Guidelines

Deadline: Annually, October 1st

The Fran Snygg Endowment Fund was established to develop and enhance awareness and appreciation of dance as a performing art. This Fund will be used to support and promote modern dance and movement in the arts, including but not limited to support for visiting artists, student scholarships and/or travel, dance production support, supplies and equipment for dance programs and/or facilities, and creative projects in modern dance and movement. It is anticipated that income from the Fund will make available about \$2,000 each year. There are two distinct funding opportunities – the Fran Snygg Endowment Fund and the Fran Snygg Grant (Arts Week). This announcement pertains to the Fran Snygg Endowment Fund.

Proposals will be considered from any of the following:

1. Indiana University Bloomington schools
2. Indiana University Bloomington departments
3. Indiana University faculty
4. Groups of collaborators that include at least one full-time IUB faculty member

Proposals must include the following information:

1. A cover sheet indicating the name of the organization, names of participants, faculty member's name, address, telephone number, fax number, and e-mail; name of the event/project.
2. A description of the goals and activities of the event/project.
3. A rationale: purpose and significance to modern dance and movement in the arts.
4. Budget.
5. List of anticipated sources of funding.
6. Curriculum vitae for the applicants, as appropriate.

Instructions: Submit **a SINGLE digital file** (Adobe pdf or Word document) containing:

- (i) The application
- (ii) Current curriculum vitae, and other relevant information
